Can I bring Food & Drinks?

There will be lots of food and drink options at Dreamworld to purchase. You cannot bring in your own food or drink.

Do I have to print my ticket?

YES, a printed ticket must be presented at Dreamworld front entry to obtain admission into the event. If you have been given a ticket directly and not received via email or SMS, please ACTIVATE the ticket immediately on the website www.MyHomeDoctor.com.au

What time do the gates open?

The gates will open at 6pm sharp with the night ending at midnight.

Can I give my ticket to someone else?

Yes you can, Yes, however tickets are uniquely numbered and will only grant ONE (1) access to the park. Duplication of the same ticket will void your entry.

Can I buy more tickets?

No, this is a private event and only ticket holders provided with a ticket can enter.

Does my child need their own ticket?

Yes they do. All people who attend on one of the nights hosted by Dial A Home Doctor must have a ticket regardless of age.

Do I need to bring ID?

No you don't. You do however have to be able to provide a unique ticket.

What if I am unable to come - can I come the next night?

Unfortunately your ticket is only valid for the night shown on the ticket. It is not transferable for this privately hosted event.

Can I use my Dreamworld Annual Pass?

Not this time! As this is a privately hosted event, only tickets issued by the team at Dial A Home Doctor through the automated competition draw or with pre-issued tickets can attend the event.

Does it include WhiteWater World?

Bbrrrrrr... no it's too cold...and besides swimming at night is just a little dangerous.

I have a Disability- can I still come?
