

Islamic Women's Association of Qld Inc.

On Saturday the 21st April 2007 from 1.30pm to 3.30pm the Islamic Women's Association of Qld Inc. held a Special General Meeting at the Slacks Creek Progress Hall. Eighty one financial members attended and a number of impartial observers from Government Departments, Community Organisations, and legal representatives were present for the meeting.

Outcomes from the Special General Meeting were as follows:

1. Election of impartial Chairperson for the meeting (ACCESS INC, Director, Gail Kerr)
2. The Management Committee was removed from office under Rule 13 for:
 - a. Trying to stop this Special General Meeting which was properly called;
 - b. Not having sufficient proper meetings and failing in its management responsibility (s.60 of the Act);
 - c. Acting against the interests of the Association and its members.
 - d. Internal squabbling
3. A further Special General Meeting is called for Saturday, 19th May 2007 to:
 - a. appoint a new Management Committee;
 - b. make such amendments to the Rules of this Association as it considers will assist the achievement of its objectives;
 - c. Consider any other urgent business that could not otherwise be handled by a new Management Committee fulfilling its role.
4. In the meantime:
 - a. the purported termination of the employee of Association's Manager, Galila Abdelsalam be revoked;
 - b. the keys to the administration office be restored to proper staff only;
 - c. The signatories on Association's bank account are restored as they were prior to 20/04/2007.
5. Business as per the notice calling meeting.

All resolutions were passed either unanimously or with only one dissenter. .

Four former members of the outgoing Management Committee wish to have it know that they were not aware or informed about actions allegedly taken by the former Management Committee.

A Special General Meeting has been organised on the 19th of May 2007, where a new Management Committee will be elected. In the meantime the Manager, Galila Abdelsalam will continue to manage all the good work .
