ELIGIBILITY

Two scholarships will be available to provide financial support to recipients in completing a Diploma of Business: specialisation Entrepreneurship at Southbank Institute of Technology, Kangaroo Point Campus in Semester 1, 2008 and membership access to the Enterprise Centre for 6 months from Semester 2, 2008.

*NB: Applicants must be from migrant/refugee background who are Australian citizens or permanent residents living in Brisbane City Council local government region with financial difficulties.

VALUE

The scholarship is valued at \$4,000 each over 1 year to cover tuition fee (18 weeks) and membership fee of the Enterprise Centre.

SELECTION

The Scholarship recipient will be chosen by a panel comprising representatives of the Lord Mayor's Multicultural Round Table and Southbank Institute of Technology.

Selection will be based on a number of criteria including:

- Business operation and industry experience and management knowledge in Australia and/or overseas;
- > Economic or personal need
