Terms and Conditions

Please read and understand the following terms and conditions and sign at the end to acknowledge that you understand your obligations in participating in the camp

1. Islamic Code of conduct

The organizing committee (Al-Nisa & Famsy) endeavours to organize the camp in the true spirit of personal development and strives to maintain the Islamic standards of behaviour and dress at all times. Below is an outline of each participant's responsibilities towards maintaining these standards.

.1.1 General Behaviour

It should be duly noted that this is not a comprehensive code of conduct and that all participants will be expected to abide by the general and specific laws of Islam pertaining to personal behaviour and social interaction.

1.2 Islamic Dress Code

All persons shall abide by the Islamic code of dress during the camp.

1.3 Accommodation and Movement

No persons will be permitted to travel outside the confines of the camping area unless he/she has prior approval from the organizing committee.

Female and male accommodations shall be separate and under no circumstances will persons of a particular sex be permitted to enter the accommodation facilities of the opposite sex.

1.4 Intoxicants, drugs and consumable items.

No persons will be permitted to carry any form of intoxicants (Beer wine etc) or drugs during the camp.

No form of intoxicants (Beer wine etc) or drugs may be consumed during the camp.

Smoking shall not be permitted during the camp.

No consumable items which are known to be prohibited in Islam (Haraam) may be offered to other persons (This includes cigarettes).

1.5 Gender Relations

In addition to the rules concerning "Accommodation and Movement" the following rules regarding gender relations shall be observed at all times:

No two persons of the opposite sex will be permitted to seclude themselves from the rest of the participants at any time during the camp.

Seating Arrangements will be segregated

Mixed Gender relations should not occur for socialising

1.6 Dealing with Misbehaviour

If any persons are found guilty of breaching the rules specific to this camp or are found guilty of behaving in an “un-Islamic” manner, as decided by the organizing committee, the committee shall meet to discuss the most appropriate course of action. In all cases the person/s found guilty must comply with the decisions of the organising committee. This includes not following the guidelines and instructions of Supervisors and the organising committee.

2. Insurance

Whilst the organizing committee endeavours to ensure participants’ safety, we do not have insurance cover and require all participants to have their own insurance cover. The Islamic Camp will not accept any liability for any injuries/trauma sustained while participating in the camp.

3. Registration and Entry Fee

Each participant in the Islamic Camp must complete a registration form and pay the entry fee by the 21 February 2011. Persons who fail to pay by this time shall not be eligible to take part in the camp.
