The awards

Eight winners will each receive an award and a \$2000 cash prize at a special award ceremony during April 2008.

Teachers, recognised community leaders and organisations can nominate young volunteers in the Individual and Group categories.

To be eligible for an award, the nominee must reside in Queensland and the volunteering activities must have occurred in the last 12 months, while the nominee was aged between 12 and 25 years.

The selection committee will select award winners by assessing each nomination against the above criteria. The authenticity of the winning submissions will be verified.

The committee will include representatives from youth organisations, Volunteering Queensland and the Department of Communities.

The selection committee's decision on the Queensland Young Volunteer Awards winners is final.
